About the courses

SELC Cambridge Test Preparation Courses teach all the language skills, with emphasis on:

NB: Students doing the Cambridge Test Preparation course must complete the full course (10 or 12 weeks) and must also sit the exam at the end of that course.

ABOUT THE EXAMINATIONS

Cambridge General Certificate Examinations

The examination for each level consists of five exams: Reading, Writing, Use of English, Listening and Speaking

FCE – First Certificate in English

- *Upper Intermediate*

FCE is the most popular of all the Cambridge examinations. It is for students who can use English confidently in a variety of situations and is proof of ability to do office work or take a course of study in English. Students who pass the FCE can work effectively in many clerical, secretarial and managerial positions.

CAE – Certificate in Advanced English

- *Advanced*

CAE is an increasingly popular examination for students at advanced level who may need English for work at a professional or managerial level or who want to follow a course of academic study at university level.

CPE – Certificate of Proficiency in English

- *Advanced*

CPE is a very advanced examination for students whose level is approaching that of an educated native speaker. It is proof of ability to cope with a high level of academic work. The course is suitable for those who have a wide vocabulary, enjoy literature and a range of other reading material, and can talk fluently about any topic.
